Capital Cup WorldSkills Competition

## **Package Information**

We sincerely welcome all international team members to Taipei to participate in the "2026 Taipei Capital Cup WorldSkills Competition".

We cordially invite the Mongolian team to Taiwan for exchanges. We invite Mongolian expert (Batbayar Munkhbayar / E3037289), trainer (DEMBEREL Liza / PE0049858) and competitor (NOMIN Ganbat / E3078004) to participate in the 2026 Taipei Capital Cup WorldSkills Competition. The organizer will provide accommodation, meals and transportation, and subsidize part of the airfare.

Regarding the subsidy for accommodation, transportation, and airfare for the "2026 Taipei Capital Cup WorldSkills Competition".

The organizer will subsidize each overseas member's airfare up to US\$800. The organizer requires the following documents. If members need these documents to process expense reimbursement upon returning home, we will keep a copy of the documents by taking photos and signing them.

Overseas groups need to provide boarding pass stubs, electronic boarding passes, electronic tickets, or other documents that sufficiently prove the itinerary. If overseas groups need to bring the documents back to their home country for verification, the organizing school will keep them by taking photos and signing them. The cabin class will be based on economy class, and the ticket price will be capped at US\$800 per person, subject to verification and payment.

According to the reimbursement requirements, overseas teams must provide receipts or electronic receipts for round-trip airfares. The receipts must clearly show the amount of the airfare purchased, converted to New Taiwan Dollars (NTD). Those who cannot provide receipts to prove the purchase amount will not be eligible for reimbursement. For round-trip airfares exceeding NT\$25,000 (USD 800), USD 800 will be reimbursed in cash. If the amount after conversion is less than NT\$25,000, the actual amount will be converted to USD cash for the overseas team to sign for.

The subsidy is capped at US\$800 per person (including one expert, one trainer, and one competitor). If your country has three participants and the round-trip airfare per person exceeds US\$800, you will receive a subsidy of US\$2,400. If your country has a fourth member traveling to Taiwan, the airfare will be borne entirely by the individual. Accommodation, meals, transportation, and other services will be charged at US\$600.

For overseas teams seeking airport pick-up and drop-off services, please provide flight information by April 20, 2026. Please include your arrival time and terminal in Taiwan, as well as your return boarding time and terminal, to facilitate the arrangement of pick-up and drop-off services.

The organizer will arrange airport pick-up service on May 25, 2026. After pick-up, you will be transferred to your hotel for rest. After checking out on May 29, you will be transferred to the airport by private car. If you are participating in the Taipei City tour on May 29, you will be transferred to the airport by private car after the city tour. The organizer will arrange single-room accommodation for international groups. Please refer to the relevant accommodation information.
